*Railway Walks: LMS* is a handbook for scenic walks along ten of the best railway paths in the territory of the former London Midland & Scottish Railway. These range from the Midland Railway's express line through the Peak district to the incredible Cromford and High Peak Railway, built before railway engineering had fully evolved, incorporating a series of level sections connected by mountainous inclines. Between these two extremes, the Rambler can explore the Brampton Valley Way in Northamptonshire, with its gentle countryside and stone villages, or a network of lines radiating from Lancaster into the delightful Lune Valley.
